She also holds the esteemed position of Concertmaster for both the Rocky Mountain Symphony and the Key30Orchestra, an orchestra known for its multicultural fusion and support of local artists.

Angela's journey in music has been marked by notable milestones, including being a featured performer at the 2023 Calgary Stampede Bell Grandstand Show for the second consecutive year, as well as a memorable appearance at the Canadian Juno Awards alongside distinguished artists Jesse Reyez and Tenille Townes.
